About the ReFrame Stamp

The ReFrame Stamp is awarded to narrative and animated features that hire **"qualifying candidates" - women, non-binary, gender non-conforming and transgender people** - in 4 out of 8 key roles including writer, director, producer, lead, co-leads, and department heads. Additional points are awarded to productions that hire women of color in key positions, and to those with overall gender parity in their crew.

Using data from the ReFrame Stamp for Narrative Feature Film, the 2023 ReFrame Voter Guide identifies qualifying candidates eligible for film awards. The Guide covers the following major awards categories, consistent with the scope of ReFrame Stamp data:





7 of the year's 100 most popular films had a woman cinematographer.

Of the 7, 1 cinematographer was a woman of color.

Mandy Walker was the only qualifying candidate nominated for Best Cinematography for *Elvis*.

Best Cinematography is the only Academy Award a woman has never won.



2022

10% of the year's 100 most popular films had a qualifying candidate as a composer.

9 films had a woman composer, and 1 film had a non-binary composer.

Of the 10, 3 composers were women of color.

10% was an all-time high in ReFrame's data since collection began in 2017. However, no women or other qualifying candidate composers were nominated for the Academy Awards. **Best Cinematography**
